

BWF MANAGER Version 1.00 (for Windows and Macintosh)

Operation Manual

Important: Please read fully before installation and use

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Overview

“BWF Manager” is a software utility application that enables the user to analyze a selected BWF(Broadcast Wave Format) poly format file and create individual BWF mono files for each track of the poly format file, which will be placed in a designated folder.

Installation and removal

There is no installer program with BWF Manager. When you extract the downloaded file, two files are created; “readme.pdf” (this file) and the software program itself. When you uninstall this software, delete both of these files. In Windows also delete “BWFManager.ini” that is created when you run this software.

Operation

1. Start “BWF Manager” and type or select the path of the BWF poly format file in the “Source file path” window.
2. The file information will be displayed in the left section of the application window. Check the boxes for each of the tracks that you wish to separate.
3. Select the folder where you wish the separated mono files to be placed . This will be displayed in the “Output folder path” window.
4. Press the “Convert” button to begin the separation process.
